# EM MEN 3-ON-3 Basketball Tournament Match Guideline

### 1. Drawing Process

- An arrangement of drawing lots before Tournament. All teams will be divided into 2 groups (each group has 4 teams) randomly with a group number. A box with 8 labels for each team's name will be prepared for drawing.
- Facebook Live (NHA HOME Centre) for the drawing process on 1 March (Thursday) at 3pm.
- Results will be shown on the Facebook Page and phone call will be made to inform the representative.

## 2. Matches Arrangement

- Each group would have their competition in 2 courts concurrently
- All matches are done in half-court model and each team has 3 players at the court for competition with the other 2 for substitution.
- All team will have the group matches first (4 groups) and then the 1<sup>st</sup> from each 4 group will go into the play-off matches (2 matches).
- The 1<sup>st</sup> teams from the 2 matches in play-off matches will go into Final match while the 2<sup>nd</sup> teams will go into third/fourth match.
- Only 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> would be awarded
- All teams' players should bring their HKID or other documents (e.g. Student ID Card) for checking on match day. All players must born on or before 31/12/2000.
- Registration time and warm up time is from 6:00pm to 6:30pm. Late for register will be considered as disqualified.
- Replacements of players are allowed but only can be the substitute players who have already registered in the application form.

#### 3. Content of the matches

- In the **group matches**, each match lasts 10 minutes preciously without any time stopping. Each team has One Pause for strategy adjustment with 30 seconds.
- In the play-off matches, each match lasts 10 minutes preciously without any time stopping.

- Each team has Two Pause for strategy adjustment with 30 seconds.
- Each team can substitute their player at any time under the permission of the referee.
- If the scores are the same during the regular time, there will be extra time of 2 minutes for additional match continuously until a team wins out (Score reach 21 marks). Only under the accident or emergency should the referee stop the time.
- After each match, there will be 2 minutes break for next matches.
- Team representative/players should sign the score sheet from the assistant referee/staff counters as confirmation after each match.
- In the Third/Fourth and Final matches, each match lasts 20 minutes (10 minutes for a half match with 1 minute break in the middle). If the sores are the same during the regular time, there will be extra time of 5 minutes for additional match continuously (The team with the highest score win).

## 4. Disqualification

- Late for register will be disqualified
- A team losing by default or tortuous forfeit will be disqualified
- Player(s) acts of violence, verbal or physical aggression, tortuous interference in games result will be disqualified.
- A player committing 2 unsportsmanlike fouls will be disqualified from the game by the referees.
- If a team gives up or cannot finish the match accordingly will be viewed as lose the match.

#### 5. Rules

- Rules are based on the **3x3 Official FIBA Basketball Rules (2016) of the Game**. For the details please check the attachment.
- Before the match, referee and staff will check the starting lineup of each team and their members' information.
- Referee would use a coin to decide which team start ball first.
- Any inquiry about the rules during the matches depends on the final decision and explanation of referees or staffs.
- In case of any disputes, the decision of HOME CENTRE is final and binding.

### 6. Score

- In half-court model that shooting in the arc line gets 1 score and shooting out of the arc line gets 2 scores.
- If any player of a team makes a foul in a round, the other team would get the ball back to restart the round rather than get the foul/free shot.
- Fouls count in total for a team. Up to **Six Fouls**, the team will get a penalty that the other team obtains a Foul Shot (1 score) in the penalty line.
